

Use the example below as a guide in writing your personal biography. Tell us your name and nickname, address, phone and email (*for contact purposes only; private information will not be included in the book*), your FBINAA Chapter, date and place of birth, and any education received prior to the Academy.

Tell us what department(s) you have served with, when you joined, what units you've served with, locations and stations, special units or programs, awards and medals received, current rank (or rank at retirement), and the date you retired (if applicable).

Tell us your FBINA Session Number and date graduated, FBINAA Positions held, and any memorable experiences from your time at the Academy or in your law enforcement career.

Note: your 200-word biography will be included for FREE; however, a 15¢ charge per word applies after the first 200 words.
