Sample Biographies for the FTRA 125th Anniversary Commemorative Book

ALVERNON "AV" ROGERS, born Sept. 25, 1954, in Arkadelphia, is a veteran of the United States Army during the Vietnam Era. He joined the Arkadelphia Police Dept in 1982 and left after five years there to accept employment with the Arkansas Highway Police (AHP). After one year with the AHP, Alvernon was commissioned as a State Trooper on Sept. 6, 1988, one of 33 graduates from Recruit Class 90.





Alvernon worked various patrol assignments before transferring into the Administrative Services Div. to serve as a Recruiter, Physical Fitness Instructor and Recruit Class Drill Instructor. A recipient of the Distinguished Meritorious Service Award, Alvernon was selected Trooper of the Year by the Sherwood Rotary Club in 2005, Trooper of the Year by the Central States Troopers Coalition in 2011, and Trooper of the Year by the ASP in 2013. He retired on Sept. 1, 2015.

Alvernon, who lives in Bryant with his wife, Phyllis, has one son, Court T. Rogers, and four grandchildren gers, Jr., Christian J"Coristian Jacoba Sallivan and Nakesha"

JAMES H. "JIM" TYLER, born Oct. 25, 1941, in Little Rock, was commissioned as a State Trooper on July 1, 1965, Recruit Class 66-C. Jim worked driver's license examination, undercover gambling and vice assignments.





Promoted to Sergeant on June 1, 1967, Jim was assigned to the Central Records Unit and later to the Personnel Office. On Oct. 15, 1976, he was promoted to Lieutenant in the Personnel Office; and on Feb. 19, 1979, to Captain serving as Administrative Assistant-Staff Coordinator in the Director's Office. On Sept. 1, 1980, Jim was promoted to Major over the Administrative Services Division, a position he held until his retirement on Oct. 31, 2000.

In 1991, Jim received a Distinguished Service Award. Jim and his wife, Margaret, who predeceased him, have one daughter, Sheri Ann Kennedy of Tacoma, WA.




